Payment Policy:

- 1. Tuition is due on or before July 1, 2018. Tuition is payable in full unless the quarterly or monthly payment plan is selected.
- 2. The quarterly and monthly payment plans include a deferral fee of 5% of the annual tuition due with the July 1 payment and require enrollment in the EFT (electronic funds transfer) program.
- 3. The quarterly plan consists of four payments due July 1, October 1, January 1, and April 1. The monthly plan consists of ten payments due July 1 and the 1st of each subsequent month, August through April.
- 4. A NON-REFUNDABLE enrollment deposit of \$1,500 is due March 1, 2018 for currently enrolled students or on the contract date for newly enrolled students. This deposit will be applied on the July 1 tuition statement.
- 5. The TUITION AND FEE OBLIGATION IS FOR THE ENTIRE 2018-2019 SCHOOL YEAR and will not be waived or refunded unless written notice of withdrawal is received by Kinkaid prior to June 15, 2018.
- 6. Payments not received by the due date are considered delinquent. A \$40 late fee plus interest of 1.5% per month will be assessed on delinquent accounts.
- 7. Final report cards and transcripts may not be released for students with delinquent accounts. Students with delinquent accounts from a previous year may not be allowed to return to school in August.

Mandatory Fees and Additional Costs:

- To help fund the cost of facilities, all new students pay a \$1,500 new student fee with the July 1 payment. (This fee is not included in the above tuition schedule.)
- Middle and Upper school textbooks (new and used) are purchased from the school store. The average cost for new books is approximately \$920 in the Middle School and \$1085 in the Upper School.
- Additional charges for class trips and other school expenses vary by grade level and activity.
- Lunch is available daily to students in grades 1-12. Purchases in the cafeteria may be made by enrolling in the
 fixed price lunch plan or on an a la carte basis. Cash is not accepted in the cafeteria and all purchases are
 charged to the student's account. Information regarding lunch options is sent to parents during the summer.
