** Other mandatory fees and additional costs are listed below. Tuition amounts include student fees which help cover the costs of educational supplies, student photos, publications, gym uniforms and various educational programs.*

Tuition Payment Policy:

1. Tuition is due on or before **July 1, 2019**. Tuition is payable in full unless the quarterly or monthly payment plan is selected.
2. The quarterly and monthly payment plans include a deferral fee of 5% of the annual tuition due with the July 1 payment. Deferral fees range from \$1,209.50 to \$1,409.75 depending on student's grade.
3. The quarterly plan consists of four payments due July 1, October 1, January 1, and April 1. The monthly plan consists of ten payments due July 1 – April 1.
4. A **NON-REFUNDABLE and NON-TRANSFERABLE** enrollment deposit of \$1,500 is due March 1, 2019 for currently enrolled students or on the contract date for newly enrolled students. This deposit will be applied on the July 1 tuition statement.
5. The **TUITION AND FEE OBLIGATION IS FOR THE ENTIRE 2019-2020 SCHOOL YEAR** and will not be waived or refunded unless written notice of withdrawal is received by Kinkaid prior to June 15, 2019.
6. All families are required to enroll in Smart Tuition's auto debit program to pay for monthly incidental charges (dining center, school store, etc.) and quarterly and monthly tuition charges.
7. If payments are not received by the due date they are considered delinquent:
 - a. A \$40 late fee plus interest of 1.5% per month will be assessed on delinquent amounts.
 - b. Students with delinquent accounts will not be allowed to begin school in August.
 - c. Students with a past due amount of 60 days or more may not attend class or participate in school activities. In addition, enrollment contracts, final grades, and/or transcripts may not be released for students with delinquent accounts.

Mandatory Fees and Additional Costs:

- To help fund the cost of facilities, all new students pay a \$1,500 new student fee with the July 1 payment.
- Mandatory trip fees will be charged as follows:

○ 6 th Grade Retreat	\$ 525
○ 7 th Grade Texas Trip	\$ 500
○ 8 th Grade Washington DC Trip	\$1,600
○ 9 th Grade Freshman Retreat	\$ 250
- Middle and Upper School textbooks (new and used) may be purchased from the school store. The average cost for new books is approximately \$350 in the Middle School and \$750 in the Upper School
- Lunch is available daily to students in grades 1-12. Purchases in the cafeteria may be made by enrolling in the fixed price lunch plan or on an a la carte basis. Cash is not accepted in the cafeteria and all purchases are charged to the student's account. Information regarding lunch options is sent to parents during the summer.
